



**YRRC Board Meeting Minutes
March 3, 2025**

YRRC Board Meeting at Sign of the Horse called to order at 6:10 pm by Heather Roe, President.

Secretary's Report:

Motion to approve January Meeting Minutes- Approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Matt Neff supplied the board with the current bank balance, noting that the expenses from the Hanover 7 miler still need to be paid. He shared Karen Duckett's proposal for the White Rose Run to have the board round up the donation to Bell Socialization from the \$9.9k raised by the race to an even \$10k donation. Motion Approved.

Old Business:

- Rail Trail 10 Miler Race will now officially be a club race.
- Google drive has been created for club documents, just need to grant access for club officers.
- Scholarship deadline will be extended to get in more submissions.
- Black Cat timing submitted a proposal to time all YRRC club races for the 2025 year. Board approved.

New Business:

- Karl Muncher came to talk about the Carrie 5k that will take place on the old David Tome course from the Spring Grove High School on 5/3/25. This is slated as a one time fundraising race unless it sees a large turnout. Currently at 52 registrants, hoping to get to 200. Karl is looking for some help coordinating. The club will lend mile markers, cones, vests, etc.
- Bursting Bubble 5k Walk/ Run 5/4/25 at John Rudy Park. Bernice Quenesberry has asked for \$1,000 sponsorship from the club, but the club will support in other non-monetary ways.
- David Levy from the new York Fleet Feet was in attendance and expressed his excitement to be partnering with the YRRC. The store will offer a 10% discount to active club members and is looking to have vendor events and group runs / long runs from the store. He has offered bib support as well as being a bib pickup location for club events as needed.
- Jason Logue (Run PA) has asked for a time clock from the YRRC to keep in his possession either as a lend from the club or a rental. These are currently being kept at the old Flying Feet/ New Fleet Feet location.

Insurance:

Discussion on what makes a group run official- anytime club members get together and use the YRRC name, it is a group run. Informal get togethers are not considered group runs.

Trail Races:

- **Lake Redman 9 Miler**- will be in December 2025
- **Squirrely Tail** was rescheduled to 2/23 and saw 95 finishers.
- **Slopeside** date set at 8/16, has some exciting swag and looking for more registrants, only 11 so far.
- **Blazing Saddles** is scheduled for 3/15/25 and is almost sold out. Course is in good shape; trail maintenance hours have been met for the year.
- **Trails for Tails 2025** date 9/13/25 and a few registrations have come through.
- **Hex Hollow**- This race sold out in 2024, and we are looking to add 25 spots to the 2025 race.

-Tuesday Group Runs- Larry Baker to discuss with Eric Ferree about ownership of the Tuesday runs/ timely posting of meetup locations.

Road Running Report:

- **White Rose 5 Miler**- This race will have a new course for 2025 involving the Prospect Hill Cemetery, working on getting registration open.
- **Winter Series**- Excited to pass along the series to the new director Grayce Langheine.
- **Shoehouse 5 Miler**- Kona to come back for 2025. We need to let the members know what we are doing with the proceeds from the race. Registration opening soon.

Events Committee:

-Committee members not present at meeting. Potential for another summer pool party at Green Valley Pool. More to come.

Membership Updates:

- Current memberships are at 704, up from 654 last year.
- Still working on a new member welcome packet.

Operations:
